Dear Friends,

Greetings from SPARSH Hospitals. Indian Society of Anaesthesiologists. Indian Association of Paediatric Anaesthesiologists. Research Society of Anaesthesiology & Clinical Pharmacology. We have great pleasure in inviting you for "Paediatric Trauma CME - 2014"

Trauma or unintentional injury is a significant cause of morbidity and mortality in children. According to a 2004 WHO report, there were over 950,000 deaths due to unintentional injury in children under the age of 20, of which only around 29,000 (3%) occurred in the high income countries. The major causes were road traffic accidents (22%), drowning (16%) and burns (9%). (There is no such data available for India or other low income countries though the numbers would be considerably higher). An important cause for childhood injuries, which is commonly overlooked, is physical and sexual abuse.

An anaesthesia provider may have to take care of an injured child for initial stabilization in the emergency department, provide sedation and monitoring for imaging, emergency surgery such as laparotomy or craniotomy, semielective surgeries such as stabilization of long bone fractures, management in the intensive care unit and control of pain including regional analgesia. At this CME program we hope to discuss these situations at length with lectures from experts, case presentations and discussions led by our paediatric fellows and even participate in a quiz on how to manage the traumatised child. At the end of the day we hope we will all take home some additional knowledge that will make the world a safer place for our children.
